### 6. Editorial

Wyndham v. Wixon

Many of you have called into us asking about the settlement that has been reached in the pending class action lawsuit named above. I'll give you the details of this settlement and some background on what it means to you. Please note the settlement has not been approved, but it appears more than likely to. The settlement does consist of some compromises from both sides, but I feel that it does offer Worldmark owners some benefits. The settlement among other things will reduce (by a small amount) the amount of credits needed to book in redseason for most resorts. It will also remove the "Fun Time" benefit from Travelshare. Wyndham will no longer be able to offer that feature which I feel is a big win for Worldmark owners. There will be no more issues and confusion with Fun Time vs Bonus time and I feel this will make Travelshare less desirable and hopefully help the secondary market improve. On to the details.

In 2007, Girard Gibbs represented five WorldMark Owners in filing a derivative lawsuit against former and current WorldMark directors. The Plaintiffs in the lawsuit are five WorldMark members, who argued, among other things, that Wyndham was violating the WorldMark Governing Documents with respect to: the pricing of certain new resorts; the implementation of the FunTime portion of the Wyndham TravelShare program; the number of weeks of usage that Wyndham was selling at each new resort; and Wyndham's use of the WorldMark resort properties for its own marketing and sales purposes.

The benefits to WorldMark owners in the settlement are:

1. Reducing credit values at specific WorldMark resorts. These reductions will result in the cancellation of 22 million vacation credits from Wyndham's inventory of developer credits, which means that the credits will no longer be available for sale to the public or used by Wyndham in voting.
2. Making 21 additional lower-credit value Dolphin's Cove resort units available in the Anaheim, California area.
3. Removing from the Worldmark system certain underutilized units that, based on occupancy data, WorldMark members do not wish to rent the majority of the time.
4. Eliminating the FunTime element of Wyndham's TravelShare program in new TravelShare memberships. Existing memberships will not be affected.
5. Cancelling up to 274.7 million total vacation credits now held by Wyndham as unsold developer credits. (Helping Availability to book units)
6. Limited Wyndham's use of WorldMark resorts for its own marketing and sales purposes.

Every owner has a right to do nothing, make comments at the approval hearing, or opt out of this settlement to protect your future rights for litigation. Redseason won't recommend what to do for each owner and we encourage that you do some more research to figure out the best option for you. Our personal opinion though is that this does have some benefits to us as owners, but as with all compromises, there are bound to be some things not listed that are probably in Wyndham's best interest as well. I do like the TravelShare removal of FunTime, and hopefully toning down the marketing/sales from Wyndham at the resorts.
