## **6. Vacation Highlights - Leavenworth in June - Linda**

The first part of June, my husband and I finally made it to Leavenworth...and it was everything we'd heard about and more! We have been wanting to go there for such a long time and were so excited when we made our reservations last year! If you've ever been, you know how beautiful the scenery is along the way...the rugged mountain canyons, the meadows...I believe just getting there is part of the enjoyment of Leavenworth!

Once we arrived, we loved the 2-bedroom suite....my husband's brother & his wife were meeting us there for a few nights, and luckily they didn't mind the two twin beds in the second guest room. We were on the second level which required hauling our luggage and coolers up one flight of stairs, so if that would be difficult for you just call the resort to ask for a ground-floor unit after making your reservation. We had such a beautiful view from our balcony, overlooking the second (less busy) pool and the majestic mountains....we spent much of our time just sitting out there enjoying the shade and the serenity! For most of our stay, the temperatures were in the high 70s, which was perfect....our last day was mid-80s and on the morning we left, it was ramping up into the mid-90s...so we were heading home at a perfect time! :)

Leavenworth itself is a charming little place...it has a great Safeway store for stocking up on groceries, a cute Bavarian-inspired motif for a quaint village experience and many restaurants and stores to while away the hours. There is also a park-like plaza and when we were there it hosted several high school bands showing off their skills in the gazebo....very pleasant to grab a park bench and enjoy the tunes with a latte from J5 Coffee, where they make you an amazing cup of coffee from their own freshly roasted beans! Because I have a serious gluten allergy, I was so thrilled to see that many of the restaurants have gluten free options and most servers were knowledgeable about their offerings, etc. The WorldMark resort office also has a gluten free restaurant listing if you mention it!

Since we were visiting Leavenworth after a ridiculously busy season for us, our goal was to relax more than not, but we did get in daily strolls through the "village" enjoying coffees and snacks and meals out, soaks in the hot tub, and plenty of balcony-sitting enjoying the view. We did take a few drives, our favorite being up Icicle Creek where we parked at a trailhead and enjoyed our coffee while sitting on large boulders in the sun and soaking up the beauty of the waterfalls. Our last evening, the Icicle Brewing Company was hosting a band of fiddlers and we loved the atmosphere of sitting outside with our refreshments and enjoying the live music...that was great fun!

I was saddened to see that over the summer there were many wildfires east of the mountains in that region....I am so hoping that the natural beauty of the area has not been scarred by them!

Regardless, I believe that the magic of Leavenworth is well worth getting off the beaten path and I highly recommend it to anyone who loves a great get-away!
